By the end of the day you will have a basic knowledge of how to use certain green woodworking tools along with specific techniques to put into action for creating in green wood. Whether you are an expert or a complete novice, don't panic! The course is designed for all levels of experience and ability, and a good time should be had by all.

Tea, coffee and refreshments are available throughout the day.

Being outside in the woods is an integral part of the experience and we get many comments on how pleasant it is to spend a couple of days in such a magical environment. Should it rain or be cold you will stay dry under our parachute "ceilings" and warm in the working areas with log fires. The walk down to the clearing takes about five minutes and so, if the weather is cold or wet, please dress accordingly.
